### We believe in:

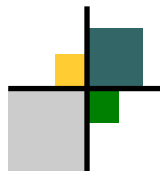
- The Holy Scriptures as originally given by God, divinely inspired, infallible, entirely trustworthy and the supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct;
- The triune God—Father, Son and Holy Spirit;
- The deity of the Lord Jesus Christ, His substitutionary atonement for sin, His bodily resurrection and His personal, visible return to earth to reign in righteousness and glory;
- The person of the Holy Spirit and His work of conviction, regeneration and sanctification, who indwells every believer equipping them with gifts for service and witness;
- The necessity of new birth, in salvation by faith in Jesus Christ alone, and the importance of a life fully committed to the will of God in Christ;
- The church as the one, universal body of Christ who is the Head, called to be God’s redeemed people.

## How is CCI supported?

CCI-Worldwide depends upon contributions for about 90% of its income. Each Association provides for its own expenses through membership dues, donations and fees for services. Association dues support 10% of the international ministry of CCI.

## Who is CCI?

CCI is a worldwide movement of Christian camping ministries that is led, managed, and governed by 21 Associations of Christian camping leaders. CCI Associations help develop effective Christ centered camps, conferences, and retreat ministries. The mission of **Christian Camping International** is to promote Christian camping throughout the world as a means of helping the Church fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ. Put simply, we have discovered we can accomplish more for the Gospel of Christ by working together.

## Where is CCI?

CCI operates as a non-denominational, evangelical movement through national and regional Associations and Networks in countries around the globe. Over 100 countries have Christian camping activities and over 50 countries are part of organized CCI Associations.

These 20 CCI members are located in Albania, Australia, Brazil, Canada, East Africa, Jamaica, Japan, Korea, Latin America, Netherlands, New Zealand, Philippines, Poland, Romania, Russia, Southern Africa, Spain, Ukraine, United Kingdom and the USA.

## Why does CCI exist?

As a worldwide movement, the objectives of CCI are:

- To strengthen the existing Christian camping Associations.
- To help new evangelical Christian camping Associations come into existence.
- To connect the various components of Christian camping for greater awareness, sharing and support.





## What does CCI do?

Each member develops its own programs and methodology to help accomplish the objectives of the international body and to meet the needs of its own country or region's membership.

The international ministry of CCI has a website ([www.cciworldwide.org](http://www.cciworldwide.org)) with a worldwide directory, news updates and resources. Periodic regional and worldwide meetings are held to foster partnerships that help develop and nurture new Christian camping Associations around the world.

## What are the Benefits?

Associations have developed in different ways around the world. Many have created a range of benefits for members including:

- Training and fellowship events (regional and national)
- Commercial discounts with companies supplying goods and services
- Resources and materials
- Advocacy to government and other official bodies representing the views of members
- Mutual support in prayer and advice from colleagues in ministry

## Non-Member Affiliation

In regions of the world where Associations do not exist, Networks of Christian camping leaders may affiliate with CCI to begin the process of expanding Christian camping in their areas. Individual camps in remote areas of the world may affiliate as Links.

The first step in developing CCI in a country or region is for like-minded Christian camping personnel to meet for the purpose of networking and fellowship. As the relationships develop, a Steering Committee can be formed in consultation with the International Director or Regional CCI Representative.

All Associations and Networks should represent a broad range of evangelical Christian denominations and organizations within the framework of the CCI Statement of Faith.

## Organizational Structure

CCI is governed by a Board of Directors that meets annually to discuss issues of mutual concern, set policy, cast vision, pray, share and encourage one another spiritually.

The International Director manages the day to day operations of the organization and implements the strategic plans established by the Board of Directors. He interacts with the leaders of the existing Associations and Networks to help expand the impact of Christian camping worldwide.

Regional CCI Representatives work to encourage and expand CCI in their parts of the world. CCI Representatives assist local Christian camping leaders in training, planning, communicating, governing, growing and establishing new CCI Associations and Networks.
